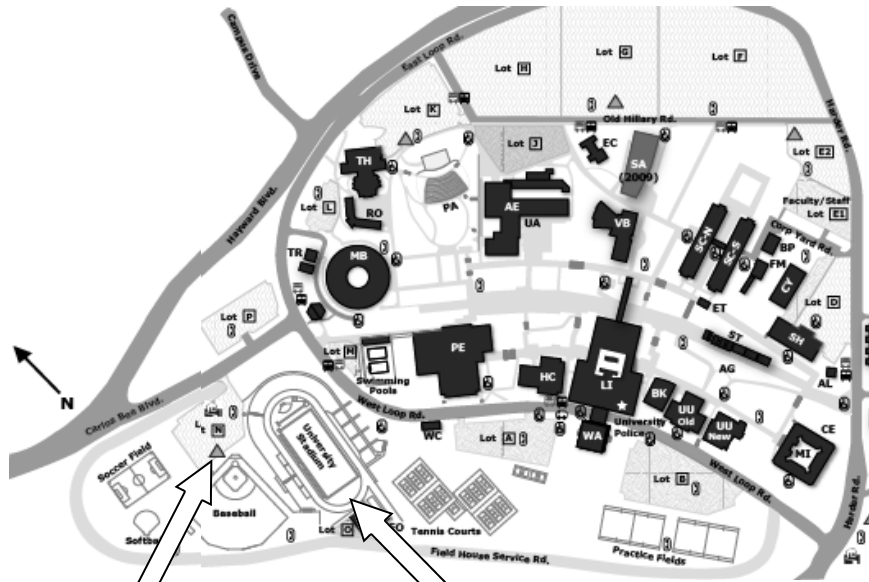

# The College of Science Commencement Ceremony

## Friday; June 11, 2010; 6:00pm

### University Stadium

#### *What You Need to Know:*

- Graduates **must line up by 4:45pm** on the practice soccer field, off of Carlos Bee Blvd. At approximately 5:40pm, graduates will begin leaving the practice field to walk down into the stadium. At 6:00pm sharp, Commencement will begin.
- Graduates and guests with mobility, hearing, or other disabilities that require special accommodations should contact: **ben.servino@csueastbay.edu, 510-885-2672** by **May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010** to submit their request. You will not be expected to line up at the practice soccer field. You will meet on the stadium floor, near the stairwell that graduates will be descending; from there you will join your fellow graduates.
- Commencement programs will be available for you and your guests at the stadium.
- **Faculty Marshals will guide you** through the ceremony. Please follow their instructions.
- You will be given an “**announcer card,**” at the practice field, on which you will write your name legibly. Your name will be read from the card as you walk across the stage to receive a certificate of participation. We will not be able to announce minors and/options.
- **Your diploma will be mailed** to your address on file after verification of all completed degree requirements. If you have requested a FERPA block be placed on your record, your name will not appear in the printed program unless otherwise requested.
- **Masters’ candidates line up separately from Bachelors’ candidates.** You will assemble on the practice field in departmental order; two abreast. You will sit next to the person with whom you stand next to.
- **Signs are arranged as follows:**

- Masters’ candidates will precede the undergraduates down **60 stairs** leading into the Stadium. Women should wear flat shoes, NOT high heels.
- Graduates will walk in two lines and please try to stay together. When you reach your row, your two lines will merge into one. Try to stay with your department and please fill each row as quickly as possible.
- Please remain standing until asked to be seated. As you go up on stage, you will give your card to the announcer on stage. Your name will be read from the card and used to keep professional photographs in order.
- **Only graduates** may walk across the stage—no infants, children, spouses, relatives, friends, etc.
- You will be photographed before, and on, the stage. You will return to your seat after leaving the stage.

Recognizing all the students takes approximately 1 ½ hours. **Please be courteous to the graduates who come after you by staying in your seat until the ceremony is over. Graduates will not be permitted to leave during the ceremony.** At the conclusion of the ceremony, you will be directed out of your seats.

## Congratulations!

#### *What Your Guests Need to Know:*

- **Graduates, please tell your guests:**
  - Proceed directly to the stadium for seating by 5:40pm in order to see the graduates walk into the Stadium.
  - Please refrain from visiting with graduates until after the ceremony.
  - There will be limited guest seating on the stadium floor, and ample bleacher seating.
  - There are no restrictions on the number of guests.
  - Parking passes will not be required. Most lots will be open to the public.
  - Vehicles with DMV issued accessible parking placards or license plates may park in spaces designated for people with disabilities in Lot B or any other lot. A shuttle bus will pick guests with disabilities in Lot B and deliver them near the designated seating area reserved for persons with disabilities on the stadium floor. **Only one personal assistant** may accompany a guest with a disability on the shuttle, on the field, and/or in the designated seating area.
  - Seating for those who require an American Sign Language interpreter will be available on the stadium floor.
